

Lead tests for Children? It's the Law!



All students under age 6 are required to have at least one blood test to check for lead poisoning - before they enter school. This Iowa law applies to children enrolling in public and private schools as well as those who are home-schooled. The only way to know if a child is lead-poisoned is to have a blood test (finger prick).
